Suggested Itinerary

Friday 31 May

Depart Australia or New Zealand and travel via Doha to Kilimanjaro airport in Tanzania.

Saturday 1 June

Arrive at 3.40pm and travel to Arusha
Overnight at *The African Tulip*



Sunday 2 June

Travel to Tarangire National Park, famous for its elephants, for a day safari.

Overnight at the beautiful *Simba Lodge* with breathtaking views of the Park.



Monday 3 June

Visit So They Can's Tanzanian Projects - Mamire Teachers' College and two of the 36 schools we support in our education collaborative.

Tuesday 4 June

Travel to Nairobi, Kenya and onto Nakuru.

Overnight at *Sunbird Lodge*



Wednesday 5 June

Visit Aberdare Ranges Primary School (ARPS) our school educating 1080 children, New Caanan Village (our Community that was once the internally displaced persons camp where the So They Can story began), our medical clinic and meet some of the women from our Wezesha Business School.

Visit Miti Mingi Village to meet our 120 orphaned and vulnerable children and their amazing house mothers and the Village Director. Stop by our Sew Women Can social business project with the opportunity to purchase some gorgeous hand crafted items.

Thursday 6 June and Friday 7 June

Travel to East Pokot. Spend the afternoon and all day Friday meeting our stakeholders, visiting some of our 7 education collaborative schools, our Micro Finance Women, community education support network and some of the families in our Family Strengthening Program.

Overnight at *Roberts Camp*



Saturday 8 June

Travel back to Nairobi for an evening flight home OR perhaps do a safari. Please contact us to discuss options and to put you in touch with a local travel agent.

Cost:

Approx \$3000AUD per person based on single room accommodation. Confirmed cost will depend on your final travel plans.
